- 4. What role does friendship play in the novel? How far would you go to protect your own friends?

- 6. Discuss the class dynamics of Opal Beach. How do they compare to your own town or city? Were you surprised by the twist of what really happened to Maureen?
- 7. Did you ultimately forgive Tammy for her involvement with Lorelei? Discuss the idea that society treats women as







disposable. Is this something you see in the world around you? How might we fix it?
